THE CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 4 of the Consumer Protection Act

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) (Amendment) Regulations 2018**.
- 2.** In these regulations —
“principal regulations” means the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Regulations 2017.
- 3.** Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended —
 - (a) by numbering the existing provision as paragraph (1);
 - (b) in the newly numbered paragraph (1), by adding the following new subparagraph, the full stop at the end of subparagraph (e) being deleted and replaced by the words “; or” and the word “and” at the end of subparagraph (d) being deleted —
 - (f) imported, subject to paragraph (2), by an individual for his personal use.
 - (c) by adding the following new paragraph —
 - (2) (a) An individual who imports goods for his personal use shall not import more than 2 goods at a time up to an aggregate of 10.

(b) Where an individual imports goods for his personal use, he shall give an undertaking, in such form as the Permanent Secretary may determine, that he will take full responsibility for the goods and their use.
