

# **Toys (Safety) (Amendment) Regulations 2018**

## **THE CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT**

### **Regulations made by the Minister under section 4 of the Consumer Protection Act**

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Toys (Safety) (Amendment) Regulations 2018**.
- 2.** In these regulations —  
  
“principal regulations” means the Toys (Safety) Regulations 1994.
- 3.** Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended —
  - (a) by numbering the existing provision as paragraph (1);
  - (b) in the newly numbered paragraph (1), by deleting the word “Every” and replacing it by the words “Subject to paragraph (2), every”;
  - (c) by adding the following new paragraph —
    - (2) (a) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to an individual who imports a toy for his personal use.
  
    - (b) Where an individual imports a toy for his personal use, he shall give an undertaking, in such form as the Permanent Secretary may determine, that he will take full responsibility for the toy and its use.
