THE NON-CITIZENS (EMPLOYMENT RESTRICTION) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 10 of the Non-Citizens (Employment Restriction) Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Non-Citizens (Employment Restriction) Exemptions (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2019.
- 2. In these regulations
 - "principal regulations" means the Non-Citizens (Employment Restriction) Exemptions Regulations 1970.
- 3. The principal regulations are amended by adding the following new regulation
 - 7. (1) Subject to paragraph (2) -
 - (a) a non-citizen being the spouse of a citizen of Mauritius and, until remarriage, a non-citizen being the surviving spouse of a citizen of Mauritius who, prior to 8 March 2019, was exempted from the provisions of section 3(1) of the Act, may, for a period of 3 months after the coming into operation of these regulations, continue to be engaged or employed as such without a permit;
 - (b) an employer may, for a period of 3 months after the coming into operation of these regulations, have a non-citizen referred to in subparagraph
 (a) in his employment without there being in force a permit in respect of the non-citizen.

- (2) The employer of the non-citizen referred to in paragraph (1) who intends to continue to have the non-citizen in his employment shall, within a period of 3 months after the coming into operation of these regulations, apply and obtain a permit in respect of the non-citizen under the Non-Citizens (Employment Restriction) (Work Permit) Regulations 2017.
- 4. These regulations shall come into operation on 28 March 2019.
