

# Consumer Protection (Consumer Goods) (Maximum Price) Regulations 2004

**GN No. 102 of 2004**

## **THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT**

### **Regulations made by the Minister under Sections 3 and 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price & Supplies Control) Act 1998**

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Consumer Goods) (Maximum Price) Regulations 2004**.
2. In these regulations -  
  
"principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Consumer Goods) (Maximum Price) Regulations 1998.
3. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is repealed and replaced by the Schedule to these regulations.
4. These regulations shall come into operation on 29 July, 2004.

Made by the Minister on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2004.

### **FIRST SCHEDULE**

(Regulation 2)

#### **Consumer goods in respect of which the maximum Wholesale and Retail prices have to be determined**

1. Bread
2. Cement
3. Cooking gas
4. Fertilizers
5. Flour including whole wheat flour
6. Iron/steel bars
7. Onions (other than the type known as "Traditional Toupie")
8. Petroleum products (including kerosene)
9. Rice (excluding luxury rice)
10. Sugar
