

## **Customs Bills (Processing Fees) Regulations 1989**

**GN 224/1989**

### **THE CUSTOMS ACT 1988 Regulations made by the Minister under section 163 of the Customs Act 1988**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs Bills (Processing Fees) Regulations 1989.
2. Subject to regulation 3, there shall be levied and paid to the Comptroller of Customs for the processing of entries at Customs a fee of-
  - (a) 250 rupees in respect of every import entry;
  - (b) 75 rupees in respect of every export entry; and
  - (c) 50 rupees in respect of every amended import entry or export entry.

3. (a) Regulation 2 shall not apply to-
  - (i) the Government of Mauritius;
  - (ii) the diplomatic corps;
  - (iii) any international Organisation under the International Organisations and Conferences (Privileges and Immunities) Act;
  - (iv) goods received from and forwarded to Rodrigues and other outer islands of Mauritius.
  - (v) an electronic declaration made by a TradeNet user.
- (b) For the purposes of paragraph (a)(v), "electronic declaration" and "TradeNet user" have the same meaning as in the Customs (use of Computer) Regulations 1997.
