

Pharmacy and Poisons (Prohibition of Harmful Drugs) Regulations 1982

GN 120/1982

Regulations made by the Minister under section 57 of the Pharmacy Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the Pharmacy and Poisons (Prohibition of Harmful Drugs) Regulations 1982.
2. In these regulations-
"harmful drug" means a substance mentioned in the Schedule.
3. No person shall import, manufacture, keep, store, distribute, sell, export, use, possess or otherwise deal with any harmful drug.
4. Any person who contravenes these regulations shall commit an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding 1,000 rupees and to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 12 months.

6. Oxyphenisatine

11. Estolate of Erythromycin
12. Azaribine
13. Phentermine
14. Any preparation containing any substance specified in paragraphs 2 to 13.
